Dear Elementary Parents,

We are looking forward to our annual “Spring Sing” on Tuesday May 10, 2016 at the Williams High School Auditorium. This year we will be performing “*A Night on Broadway with Blessed Sacrament School!*” The students have been working very hard, so please make plans to attend and invite family and friends as we will have PLENTY of room for all! **Students in 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grades should arrive dressed and ready at 5:30 p.m. with a snack. Students in preschool through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade should arrive dressed and ready at 6:00 p.m. and do not need a snack.** We will also have a full dress rehearsal during school at BSS on Monday, May 9<sup>th</sup>.

Although more costume & part details will be coming home right after Spring Break, please see the following suggestions for costumes which we need your help putting together for your child:

**Preschool, PreK** – singing, ‘*Put on a Happy Face*’: wear Sunday best – we will add sunshine 'shapes' around face & maybe 'clouds' attached to their clothes they can "brush off" during song. **Pastel colors are preferred!**

**Kindergarten:** singing, ‘*Whistle a Happy Tune*’: **Asian-style** clothes - shiny/poufy pants &/or jackets. Girls wear hair in buns if possible with glittery covering.

**1<sup>st</sup> grade:** singing, ‘*Seventy-six Trombones*’: wear marching band-style white shirt & dark pants or skirt – can even add band jackets or hats if available. We will add epaulets on shoulders. Props needed: imitation brass & woodwind instruments

**2<sup>nd</sup> grade:** singing, ‘*Give my Regards to George M. Cohan*’: wear red, white, and blue patriotic colors!

**3<sup>rd</sup> grade:** singing, ‘*Seasons of Love*’: dress in clothes from the various seasons... **Students have now been assigned what season to dress as. Another reminder will come home soon.**

**4<sup>th</sup> grade:** singing, ‘*You Can't Stop the Beat*’ AND kick off ‘*We Go Together*’: wear 50/60's attire... boys in leather jackets, white t-shirt, jeans, etc; girls in poodle skirts, bobby socks, saddle shoes, scarves tied in hair, etc.

**3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade parents especially** - please respond below regarding your child’s participation in the program. Many students will be assigned speaking parts or solos, and it is helpful to know as soon as possible if we need to reassign.
