



Tuition & Tuition Assistance 2017-2018

At Blessed Sacrament School, each child is promised an excellent faith-based education both in and out of the classroom. Our community is a family of learners, celebrating the values of the Gospel messages and recognizing the gifts of each individual student. Through the generous ongoing support of benefactors, alumni, grandparents, current parents, parishioners and friends of the school, Blessed Sacrament School is able to set tuition substantially less than the actual cost of educating each student.

Tuition Assistance is available to families who wish to provide a Blessed Sacrament School education to their children but are unable to afford the full cost of the education. All assistance is offered on the basis of demonstrated need, and all assistance recipients must complete a Grant & Aid Application through FACTS Management Services to be eligible for tuition assistance.

Note: Hours of the Little Knights program are 7:45 a.m.-3:00 p.m. and children may arrive at 7:15 AM at no additional cost. Students in the PreKindergarten class must meet the minimum age requirement (turn 5 on or before August 31) to attend Kindergarten.

Tuition Payment Options

For your convenience, tuition may be paid one of four ways:

- One payment with a 1% discount due by August 11, 2017
- Ten monthly payments through FACTS Management Services with an account draft to begin in July 2017 and end in April 2018.
- Twelve monthly payments through FACTS Management Services with an account draft to begin in July 2017 and end in June 2018. The twelve monthly payments option is only available if payments begin in July 2017.

Tuition Assistance is available to families who wish to provide a Blessed Sacrament School education to their children but are unable to afford the full cost of the education. All assistance is offered on the basis of demonstrated need, and all assistance recipients must complete a Grant & Aid Application through FACTS Management Services to be eligible for tuition assistance.
