This will be an opportunity students entering the 2nd-7th grade in the 2018-2019 school year to see what a regular day at BSS is like. Your child will be paired with an ambassador and attend classes and participate in the day's activities.

To have your child participate in this special day, please complete the response form and return it to the Admissions Office no later than Friday, October 27th. Please note that for planning purposes, this is a firm date.

Our school day begins at 7:45 a.m. so we ask that you arrive a few minutes prior so we may introduce all visitors to their buddy for the day. Immediately following our daily morning meeting, I will host a prospective parent coffee and brief tour.

At the end of the day, your child will be released to you from the school office. All visitors must be picked up by 2:30 pm.

We are excited to welcome prospective Knights on Wednesday, November 1st. This is a regular school day and all school rules, including dress codes, apply. In general, we do not allow mobile devices to be turned on during the day, we do not wear hats inside the building, and we do expect students to dress modestly and wear shoes appropriate for participation in our PE program and outdoor recess. **Students will need to pack a lunch and a snack.**
