Elementary & Middle School Curriculum

The school provides an academic program in full compliance with North Carolina Curriculum Guidelines. Blessed Sacrament School does not discriminate on the basis of race, gender or national origin. We welcome children and their families of all races, creeds and economic backgrounds.

Little Knights Preschool Curriculum

Our curriculum covers the spiritual, social/emotional, physical, cognitive, and creative expression of the child. Within these experiences, children will participate in a variety of activities that help them develop in these areas. Children will be introduced to prayer, learn how to interact appropriately with peers, and begin to take care of their own personal needs. Fine and gross motor skills will be strengthened, oral language, book knowledge, alphabet knowledge, and numbers and counting will be introduced. Science, music, and art are all integrated within the curriculum for the whole school year. Options are available for two, three, or five full or half day options.

Accreditation

Blessed Sacrament School is a member of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Raleigh School System and the National Catholic Educational Association.. The School is accredited by Southern Association of Colleges and Schools and the Catholic Diocese of Raleigh, with all full-time faculty members certified through the State Department of Public Instruction.

History

Blessed Sacrament School first opened its doors in 1935. The school was located at the home of Col. James H. Holt, with a total enrollment of 25 students. This marked the beginning of quality Catholic education in Burlington and the surrounding area – a tradition that has served the community for over 75 years.

After Blessed Sacrament

Blessed Sacrament students have successfully transitioned to both public and private high schools. Over the past 6 years, 40% of our student have gone on to public schools, 11% to charter schools and 49% to private schools.
